Dear Pre-K Families,

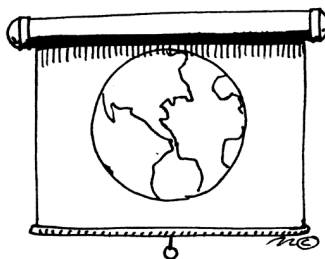
